

## Workshop Camera Club Equipment

The Club owns a Colormunki computer screen calibrator and a Nikon slide/film scanner. Both are available for loan to Club members under the following conditions:

- The equipment is the property of Workshop Camera Club and is loaned to members for their own personal use. It is NOT to be lent to 3<sup>rd</sup> parties for any reason.
- Persons wishing to borrow need to advise the “Equipment Officer” by email at [equipment@workshopcameraclub.org.au](mailto:equipment@workshopcameraclub.org.au) . Names will be added to the waiting list in order of receipt of request.
- Upon receiving advice that the requested equipment is available the member has 3 days to make arrangements to pick the equipment up. If the equipment is not picked up within 7 days of notification then the equipment will be offered to the next member on the list. If the displaced member still wishes to borrow the equipment they will have to re-apply and re-join at the bottom of the waiting list.
- Members who advise within 1 day that they are unable to use the equipment in the allocated time slot will only drop one place in the queue.
- It is the member’s obligation to arrange pick up and safe return of the equipment. Any losses or damage to the equipment may be charged to the member at the discretion of the WCC Committee.
- Members are requested to limit the time as specified below so that others get a reasonable chance. If you cannot complete the task in the time limit or have technical problems please return and book another slot. Early returns will be appreciated to improve the turnover.

- Whilst every attempt has been made to make these packages complete it will be up to the individual to install and get the systems running on their machine. No IT support is provided.
- In the case of the Nikon scanner it may not run with some operating systems, eg, Windows Vista and 7 due to age of the software, circa 2001. Note that scanning is a very slow process and 24 negatives take approx 90 minutes to scan.
